

COURT APPROVED NOTICE FROM LANDLORD TO TENANT - FIFTEEN DAY
NOTICE FOR POSSESSION OF PREMISES

15 Day Notice, if the landlord needs possession of this property and it is not for any of the previous reasons and the rent is paid on a month to month basis, this form would be used giving the tenant a fifteen day written notice to vacate the premises. The notice would state that the rental agreement is terminated and no further rent would be accepted. This notice should be given fifteen days prior to the rent being due. If the tenant does not vacate, the landlord would file his complaint for eviction. **If a written lease agreement has been entered into, this section does not apply.**
