**MOTION TO DIRECT DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO REINSTATE
DRIVER'S LICENSE AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION PRIVILEGES**

The undersigned child support obligor moves the court to direct the reinstatement of his/her Florida driver's license and vehicle registration privileges to the extent that such privileges have been administratively suspended by the Florida Department of Revenue for failure to pay court-ordered child support and/or alimony, on the ground that he/she lacks the present ability to pay either the full amount of the arrearage or the amount required by Department of Revenue for reinstatement, whichever is less, and that it is in the best interests of the child or children in this case that such privileges be reinstated.

The obligor requests that the court schedule this matter for an early hearing because he/she needs reinstatement of these privileges in order to seek or retain employment, which is the only or primary means he/she has to obtain funds in which to pay child support, alimony, or arrearage obligations.
