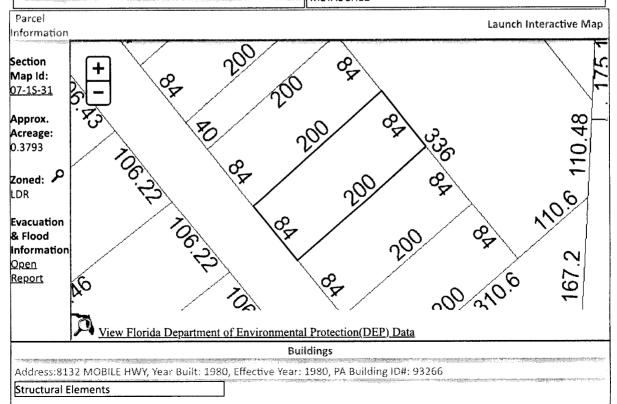

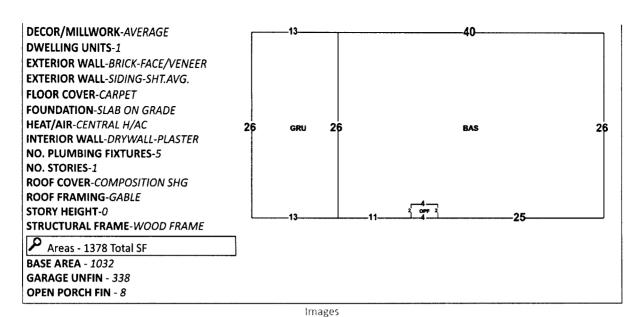

RESTRICTIONS

- No parcel shall be used except for residential purposes of purposes indident thereto. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any parcel other than a single family dwelling.
- 2. No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any parcel nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance to the neighborhood.

No trailer, mobile home, double wide mobile home, expandable mobile home with or without peramnent foundation, no shack, garage, tent, barn or other outbuilding erected on the property may at any time be used in the principal residence. Holt Construction reserves the right to grant permission for a trailer or neat appearance to remain for a period of 1 (one) year only while permanent home is being constructed.
- 6. No parcel within the property shall be used for residential purpose prior to installation of toilet and bathroom facilities and sanitary and sewage convenience required for normal residential use. .

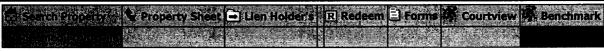
