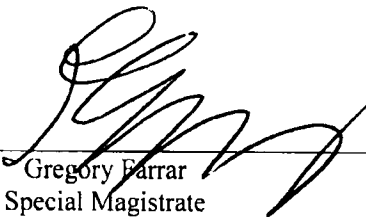
Costs in the amount of \$ 1,600 are awarded in favor of Escambia County as the prevailing party against **RESPONDENT.**
