If you fail to fully correct the violation within the time required, you will be assessed a fine of \$ 20 . 80 per day, commencing May 16, 2018. This daily fine shall continue until this violation is abated and the violation brought into compliance or until as otherwise provided by law. **YOU ARE REQUIRED**, immediately upon your full correction of this violation(s), to contact the Escambia County Environmental Enforcement Office in writing to request that they immediately inspect the property to make an official determination of whether the violation has been abated and brought into compliance. These measures could include, but are not limited to, **DEMOLISHING YOUR STRUCTURE (S), LEGALLY DISPOSING OF ALL CONTRIBUTING CONDITIONS, AND TOWING OF DESCRIBED VEHICLE (S)**. The reasonable cost of such will be assessed against you and will constitute a lien on the property.

Costs in the amount of \$235⁰⁰ are awarded in favor of Escambia County as the prevailing party against **RESPONDENT**.

This fine shall be forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners. Under the authority of 162.09(1) F.S. and Sec. 30-34(d) of the Code of Ordinances, the Board of County Commissioners will certify to the Special Magistrate all costs imposed pursuant to this order. All monies owing hereunder shall constitute a lien on **ALL YOUR REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY** including any property involved herein, which lien can be enforced by foreclosure and as provided by law.

Corrective action shall include:

Complete removal of all contributing nuisance conditions; trash, rubbish, overgrowth and legally dispose of. Maintain clean conditions to avoid a repeat violation.

Remove vehicle. Repair vehicle or store in rear yard behind 6' opaque fencing

Obtain building permit and restore structure to current building codes or, obtain demolition permit and remove the structure(s), legally disposing of all debris (as required).

Remove all structures, signs, vehicles, etc. from County ROW; refrain from further obstruction.

Subscribe for residential waste collection with a legal waste collection service and comply with solid waste disposal methods

Immediately cease burning and refrain from future burning

Remove all refuse and dispose of legally and refrain from future littering
