





At a final hearing in open court on September 17, 2010, the plaintiff appeared with counsel and the defendants appeared representing themselves. This case concerns credit extended to the defendants by plaintiff. They do not dispute that they asked for and accepted the \$5,000.00 loan. Instead, they argue that they agreed to a "fixed rate" loan not a "variable rate" loan.

Plaintiff admitted into evidence through the custodian of records, a copy of the contract signed by both defendants which clearly reflects variable rate terms.
