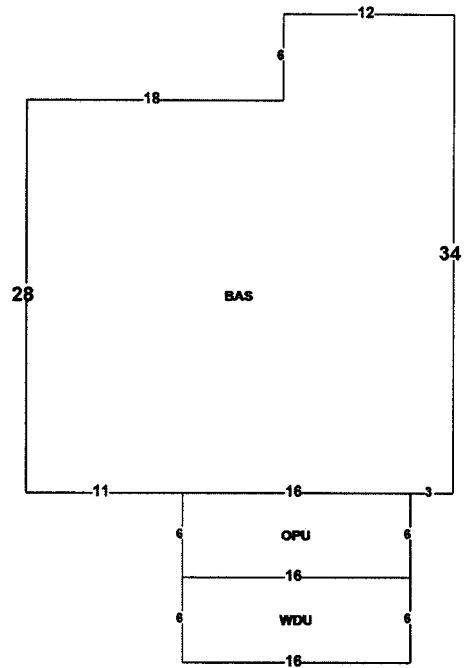

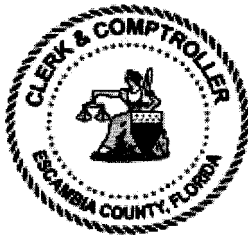

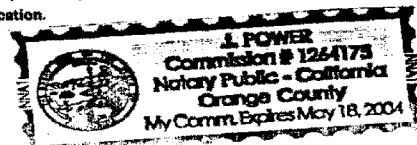

POWER OF ATTORNEY

If Respondent(s) fail to fully correct the violation(s) within the time required, Respondent(s) will be assessed a fine of **\$10.00** per day, commencing **8/28/2023**. This fine shall continue until the violation(s) is/are abated and the violation(s) brought into compliance, or until as otherwise provided by law. **RESPONDENT IS REQUIRED**, immediately upon full correction of the violation(s), to contact the Escambia County Office of Environmental Enforcement in writing to request that the office immediately inspect the property to make an official determination of whether the violation(s) has/have been abated and brought into compliance. If the violation(s) is/are not abated within the specified time period, Escambia County may elect to undertake any necessary measures to abate the violation(s). These measures could include, but are not limited to, **DEMOLISHING NON-COMPLIANT STRUCTURES, LEGALLY DISPOSING OF ALL CONTRIBUTING CONDITIONS, AND TOWING OF DESCRIBED VEHICLE(S)**. At the request of Escambia County, the Sheriff shall enforce this order by taking reasonable law enforcement action to remove from the premises any unauthorized person interfering with the execution of this order or otherwise refusing to leave after warning. The reasonable cost of such abatement will be assessed against **RESPONDENT(S)** and shall constitute a lien on the property.
