



CODE VIOLATION ORDER AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS

The Special Magistrate Judge having heard and considered sworn testimony and other evidence presented in this matter on <u>October 19, 2021</u>, after due notice to the respondent(s), makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

A. FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The respondent(s) own(s) and/or is (are) in possession of the real property located at 417 North Davis Highway, Pensacola, Escambia County, Florida, legally described as:

The following described condition exists on the property: there remains rotting wood, missing exterior wall siding, holes in the exterior walls, a deteriorating roof, peeling and unpainted wood and house numbers not displayed on this vacant residential structure and the condition constitutes an unsafe condition, lack of maintenance (protective treatment, exterior walls, roofs & drainage, premises identification) and a nuisance.
- 3. The date this condition was first observed was <u>February 22, 2021</u>; reinspection made on <u>October 19, 2021</u>, confirmed the condition still existed on that date.

In the event this order is not complied with before the above compliance date, as early as at the City Code Enforcement Authority Meeting and Hearings scheduled to take place beginning at 3:00 P.M. (Central Time) on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, or at any such meeting and hearings thereafter, without further hearing or notice to the respondent(s), : A FINE MAY BE ASSESSED AGAINST EACH RESPONDENT AND THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED PROPERTY IN AN AMOUNT UP TO AND INCLUDING TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$250.00) PER DAY for that day and each and every day thereafter any violation continues to exist; and, without further hearing or notice to the respondent(s), A LIEN MAY BE IMPOSED AGAINST ANY AND ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE RESPONDENT(S) WHICH IS NOT LEGALLY PROTECTED FROM ENCUMBERANCE AND LEVY; AND THE COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY IN SUCCESSFULLY PROSECUTING THIS CASE MAY BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE RESPONDENT(S).
